The Blanche Kelso Bruce Academy Middle School is a strict-discipline academy providing educational services to youth outside the educational mainstream in grades 5-8. Most youth outside the educational mainstream are not youth with academic challenges/failure caused by behavior problems, but rather students with behavior problems caused by failure in school – behavior escalated by non-responsive but yet mandatory education. Consequently, Blanche Kelso Bruce Academy takes an even more central role in the needed intervention in their lives because it is not just a matter of a good education allowing opportunities, it is a matter of even brief experience with targeted, healing schooling that creates a cognitive and affective transformation in the individual which empowers them to manage themselves in the challenges they face.

Our challenges are due to the transient nature of our student population, which has led to serious gaps in skill and knowledge acquisition, decreased student motivation and engagement due to past failures in school, and a school structure that does not lend itself to optimal learning, growth, academic performance and student achievement.

We are committed to closing the achievement gap and accelerating student achievement. To that end we utilize a variety of research-based best practices to re-engage our students in the learning process, to provide personalize/individualized learning, and a curriculum that is aligned to the state and common core standards. Also, we provide out of the classroom learning experiences to deepen the students understanding, provide opportunities for applied learning, problem solving in a real work context, and higher order thinking skill application.

Assignment of Students:

The Blanche Kelso Bruce Academy is a strict-discipline academy. Students assigned to our school must meet one of the three following criteria:

- Assigned by an officer of the court.
- Placed on long-term suspension from his or her school district
- Expelled from his/her school district
- Referred via his/her Individualized Education Plan (IEP).

School Improvement:

Our School Improvement Plan drives the daily instruction of students in addition to providing guidance on research-based best practices that are being implemented to promote academic and personal growth of our student body. The School Improvement Plan is also the guiding force behind decision-making with respect to the allocation of financial and human resources.

BKB Academy Middle School:

The Blanche Kelso Bruce Academy Middle School is designed to service students' grades 5-8 who have been unsuccessful in the traditional educational school setting. We are a strict discipline academy that provides core academic instruction with rigor and relevance, and we determine success by using a myriad of measures to evaluate and assess mastery of the prescribed skill sets mandated by the Michigan Department of Education Common Core Standards. Blanche Kelso Bruce Academy Middle School is also a Big Picture Learning inspired site, a framework for learning that puts the students at the center of their own education, providing time and opportunities for them to develop their passions and engage in passion/interest driven learning activities, in addition to traditional learning. It provides for a purposeful, experiential based model for our entire student body that is immersed in real world experiences that are aligned to the State Common Core Standards.

Aggregate Student Achievement:

During the 2014 – 2015 school year, the percent of students represented by parents at parent teacher conferences was approximately twenty-five percent of the population.

Blanche Kelso Bruce Academy Middle School does not currently provide a dual enrollment program, AP/IB level courses, as our student population is highly transient. Therefore, the percentage and number of students participating is zero.
